Anawan Farm CSA WorkShare Program:

Outdoors with super low covid rates and our workshare program is back in full force!

A 4-week minimum commitment is required to start earning vegetables. Your 4 weeks can be retroactive. Meaning you must work the 4 weeks, but you will earn 4 weeks while working. We try to match your skills as appropriately as possible to the jobs we have on the farm. Sometimes, we really need to keep our weed suppression down by weeding. Do NOT be discouraged. Weeding is one of, if not, THE most important job on the farm. Plants are healthier and grow faster without weeds!

All applicants are considered on a first come, first serve basis. If you are not chosen, please feel free to purchase produce at our new farm stand. We try to be as supportive to our community as possible. We encourage applicants to apply ASAP and if you have friends interested, share this info packet with them!!!!

Volunteers With Educational Benefits!

We offer attendance to other on farm workshops in and around our local vicinity. We are generous on our farm and want to encourage community participation. This is a good chance for you to learn about your local small farm.

What Kind of Veggies Are Available?

Each week will vary in the assortment of vegetables you get (some vegetables will overlap from week to week depending on what is in season). A variety of herbs, Eggplant, Summer Squash, Zucchini, Bush Beans, Radishes, Cucumbers, a variety of peppers, Sweet Corn, Kale, Carrots, Beets, Butternut (also known as winter squash), Pumpkins, Spaghetti Squash, Small bunch of Fresh Cut Flowers. Generally, we grow the most common varieties of veggies across three seasons.



AF Workshare Vegetable Pick-Up:

You may take what vegetables you would like to use upon leaving your shift. You are responsible for picking any vegetables or flowers. Please take enough for the week. If you are into canning and would like extra, just ask. We are usually more than willing to allow you to utilize more.

AF Workshare Requirements:

We usually supply appropriate protection from the sun. However, COVID has changed everything. There will be a box with your name on it, you may place your items in it, and it will be yours for the season.

The following items are required to work on our farm:

- A Large Brimmed Sun Hat
- Garden Gloves
- Sunscreen
- XL Water Bottle or Two
- Proper Shoes
- Bug Spray
- A long sleeve SPF Shirt! (Not required but definitely recommended via Land's End. They usually have a 40-50% off coupon from time to time.)



Our Expectations & What You Can Expect:

- The most important thing to keep in mind is that we are a working farm. We must work fast and efficiently.
- Workers may be asked to perform hard physical work for 4 hour periods of time: lifting up to 50lbs, bending, sitting, squatting, standing, carrying, pulling, weeding, hoeing, thinning crops, planting, harvesting, digging, washing produce, packaging produce, fulfilling online orders, cleaning up around the farm, etc.
- You must be able to withstand HEAT to participate in our work share program.
- You must be comfortable working with animals, specifically dogs. We have a large breed hypoallergenic herding dog on the farm. He is a pup at heart (4yrs old/100+lbs). Being comfortable & patient with a farm dog! Goats are also on the farm.
- There will be days when the weather is less than desirable (rain or muddy shine), but we will still work. We ask that you always review the weather report for your work share day, but also prepare for the possibility of varied weather conditions; dress appropriately for the weather and come out to the farm.
- Cell phone use: It's important that you always focus on the task at hand and refrain from using telephone/electronic gadgets personally. *We use our cell phones to text and call from one area of the farm to another. Please keep them on, charged and ready to use. EXCESSIVE PERSONAL use is not permitted.*
- You must provide your own reliable transportation.
- WORKING INDEPENDENTLY. I am not only farming but managing everything associated with our farm. I cannot be there with our workshares 80% of the time.
- Children are not allowed on the farm with our workshares. We apologize but again, we are a working farm, in need of workers without distractions. We find that a lot of parents also enjoy the break from their children when they are working their hours.
- If you cannot work on the agreed upon day, we ask that you find someone to replace your time: Another workshare, a friend, etc. That person will need to sign a release form.
- 4 Hour shifts may not be split in half. We have discovered that 2 hours is not enough time to accomplish significant tasks.
